Small-Scale Fisheries: Too big to be ignored

- About 75% of active EU fishing vessels
- Approx. 48% of employment
- Responsible for ca. 23% of total catch
- Source of traditional ecological knowledge
- Lack of data on SSF



Importance of Collaboration

Due to the role of SSF in EU Fisheries:

- SSF need to be actively involved in the implementation process / transition time
- SSF to be treated as partners
- Voices of SSF to be heard

vessel tracking, electronic catch reporting for all by 2030



Traceability (EU CATCH IT): vessel identifier, catching method and catch area






